Monday, June 29th

8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Meet at the church at 8:30 a.m. and return by 2 p.m. We will be riding on Saint Mark UMC's bus. Dress appropriately for the weather. A hat and sunblock are good ideas.

The farm is located in Tuscaloosa County and will take between 1 and 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours to reach, so you might want to bring something to entertain you on the bus.

There are lots of blueberries to pick and we can pick as much as we want. We are Gleaning these blueberries to bring back to a local agency that feeds the hungry. The farm has buckets that pick with, but then we will transfer the berries to bags to bring back home.

You may also pick and purchase berries for yourself (I am not certain of the price but will try to check on that before Monday).

Bring a picnic lunch and drink. You might want to bring an extra water bottle as well. The farm has picnic tables in the shade where we can eat our lunch. There is a restroom there.

Everyone (adults and children) must have a completed Gleaning Liability Form.
